



## Acceptable Exterior Building and Sidewalk Washing Guidelines During Water Conservation

**Using a Reclaimed Water System** - A Reclaimed Water System is a system that collects wash water, treats and reuses it for building washing. For exterior building washing, a “closed loop” cleaning and water recovery system meets the criteria of a reclaimed water system.

### Available Reclaimed Water Systems for Exterior Building Washing:



**Limitations on Exterior Washdown of Buildings**

1. *No more than once (1) per month for retail building frontage.*
2. *No more than twice (2) per year for office and commercial buildings.*
3. *No more than necessary to comply with health laws, regulations for the building frontage of food services.*
4. *No more than once (1) per year for residential structures solely for the purpose of preparing a residential structure for painting.*

**For Windows - Use a commercial glass and window cleaner**



**For Sidewalks** – Use a Reclaimed Water System and this should *not be done more often than is necessary to comply with health laws and regulations.*
